Dear Parents and Carers,

Re: History Trip – ‘The Doctors Show’ at the Cornerstone Arts Centre

Description of trip: The History department has arranged a trip to the Cornerstone Arts Centre in Didcot, to watch a performance of ‘The Doctors Show’ which relates to the students’ study of the ‘Britain, Health and the People’ topic of the GCSE History course.

‘The Doctors Show’ is a light-hearted play which tells the story of Health and Medicine in Britain since the Middle Ages. The performance focuses on key events and developments in medieval Britain, the Renaissance, the industrial period, and modern Britain.

The play is in four parts and each part leads into a workshop session that looks at how the events of the play relate to the GCSE course, and offers advice to students about how to improve their performance in their final exam. It forms a great part of students’ revision for their Britain: Health and the People module.

Date: Thursday 5th February 2026.

Location: Cornerstone Arts Centre, Didcot.

Travel arrangements: Students must be at school for the normal start time of 8:30am. We will travel by coach and expect to arrive back at school around 1:30pm.

Meal arrangements: Students will need to bring a packed lunch with them. Students entitled to Free School Meals may claim, **in advance**, a free school packed lunch through the trip leader.

Dress code: Students are required to wear school uniform to this event.

Cost: The cost of the trip is **£24.00**, payable via ParentPay.

An electronic consent form will be sent to you separately via email after payment has been received. All medical and emergency contact information will be taken from the data held on your child’s record.
