Exam Results – Summer 2026

Just a reminder that exam results may be collected from the Hall between 9:00am and 11:00am on results days, as follows:

- Thursday 13th August – A Level, AS Level and Level 3 BTEC Results
- Thursday 20th August – GCSE and Level 2 BTEC Results

Results are the property of the candidate and, as such, must not be handed out to a third party without the candidate's permission. If students would like someone else to collect results on their behalf, consent forms are available from Reception. Please remember that all third parties collecting results must bring a suitable form of ID with them on results day, and examples are given on the form.

Alternatively a stamped, self-addressed envelope may be left at reception and results will be posted. Please ensure the student's current year and form group is written in the top left-hand corner to assist with sorting into year groups.

Members of staff will be available on results days, to provide advice and assistance with any questions or concerns. In the meantime, if you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact the Exams Team.
